Home Industries Schedule

- All entries to be on official entry form (see back of schedule).
- All entries to be grown, made or created by the **named** exhibitor.
- Presentation of awards will be at **2.15pm on Show Day**.
- Entries, Cups, Trophies and Awards must remain in the hall until **3.30pm** of the Show Day.
- Judging will take place prior to show day.
- Judge's decision is final, & no correspondence will be entered into.
- A maximum of **1 entry** by one individual exhibitor **per category except where otherwise stated**.

Children's Section – Categories 1 – 25

Overall Champions Symes Trophies = For a boy and a girl most points

- Ages as at 31 December 2023.
- Food must be presented on a **plain white** disposable or china plate, covered in clear wrap or a plastic cap or as stated.
- Exhibitor name, age & phone number must be on the base of the entry.

- ✓ Vegetables & fruit must be washed with outer leaves trimmed.
- ✓ Leave the skin & roots on onions & garlic.
- ✓ Rhubarb needs to be even size & colour with a pulled base not cut
